

Faith Plans Baseline Survey

About this Survey

The purpose of this baseline survey is to enable you to gather an overview of the environmental actions you and your community/organisation/network have taken prior to developing a Faith Plan. This survey can help you identify what needs to be done and what environmental measures you can include in your Plan.

The survey will enable you to:

- Take stock of the past and celebrate the successes and learnings from commitments made already.
- Gain a clear understanding of the present, summarising the current context for each area of action.
- Set out a starting point from which to imagine and plan the future, using real world, measurable impacts to plan ideas.

This survey is designed around the seven key areas of the Faith Plans programme (www.faithplans.org/seven-key-areas).

We suggest you first download this survey, and complete over time once you have gathered responses to the relevant sections.

- You will be able to review your responses to help guide your reflection and planning for the next five to seven years. Learn from what you have done in the past and identify what you have not done but are interested in doing in the future.
